## **DISCUSSION:**

A fault code may be set in the radio when performing diagnostics using the DRB III<sup>®</sup>. The code reads "Cold CD". The fault code is not displayed to the customer and is only displayed when performing diagnostics. The fault code was intended to be displayed if the CD player was operated in extreme cold temperatures. This code should be disregarded whenever it is encountered. The fault code will be eliminated in future radios.
